Additional Information:

Students at their 8th semester are divided into six groups (1,2,3,4,5,6) and their training takes place at the spring semester and winter semester of the following academic year (8th – 9th semesters). Classes are held between the hours of 08:00 and 13:00.

Each group attends the course of Respiratory Diseases and the course of Intensive Care at the same period (2 weeks in total for each course).

Emergency Medicine: Erasmus students attend the course as a clinical clerkship, which means that they will not be awarded with ECTS credits by our Institution. They will receive an evaluation form by the Professor in charge of their training with a grade included.

Each group attends the course of Orthopedics – Traumatology and the course of Urology at the same period (2 weeks in total for each course).

Orthopedics-Traumatology: every Monday and Wednesday and the first two Fridays

Urology: every Tuesday and Thursday and the last two Fridays

Each group attends the course of Orthopedics - Traumatology and the course of Urology at the same period (2 weeks in total for each course).

ORL: every Monday – the 1st and 3rd Wednesday – every Friday

Ophthalmology: every Tuesday – the 2nd and 4th Wednesday – every Thursday
